**Documentation Required in Support of Application**

**Previously looked After Child:** We request a copy of the adoption order, child arrangement order or special guardianship order and a letter from the local authority that last looked after the child confirming that he or she was looked after immediately prior to that order being made.

**Category 1, 2 & 6:** Baptismal Certificate of child or a letter/certificate from the parish priest confirming that the child has been received into the Catholic Church.

**Categories 3, 4 & 5:** Child's Baptismal Certificate or a letter from the parish priest confirming that the child has been received into the Catholic Church and signature of parish priest on this Supplementary Information Form confirming Mass practice.

**Category 9:** Signature of church leader on this Supplementary Information Form confirming family is of the church tradition stated.

*Please note that the parish priest of St Edmund Campion parish requires a mass card to be stamped to show attendance, This does not form part of the school's allocation process. Other priests from other parishes may not require this.*

*It is only the parents attendance at Mass that counts for categories 3, 4 and 5 as young children cannot take themselves to Mass. Other adults including Grandparents do not count, as it is the parent who is applying for the place and all evidence must relate to them and their child.*
